This privacy policy sets out how MJ Solpac Limited uses and protects any information that you give to MJ Solpac Limited when you use our website, www.mjsolpac.com.

MJ Solpac Limited is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

MJ Solpac Limited may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from 16th May 2018.

What we collect

We may collect the following information when you subscribe to our newsletter, respond to a survey or complete an online form:

- name and job title
- contact information including email address and contact number
- demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests
- other information relevant to customer surveys and/or offers

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping.
- Improve our products and services.
- Send promotional emails about new products, special offers or other information which we think you may find interesting using the email address which you have provided.
- From time to time, we may also use your information to contact you for market research purposes. We may contact you by email, phone or mail. We may use the information to customise the website according to your interests.

Not all the information we hold, and use is personal information, so it won't all be covered by the new privacy notice:

- For sole traders and unincorporated partnerships, most information we hold will be personal
- For limited companies or incorporated partnerships, the privacy notice only covers information that relates to you and other key people

Use of information relating to your company will still be covered by your product terms.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. To prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online. We do not sell, trade or otherwise transfer to outside parties any personally identifiable information.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added, and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies, Google Analytics and Wordpress Jetpack to identify how often and which pages are being accessed. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website to tailor it to our customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Links to other websites

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. Controlling your personal information

We will not sell, distribute or lease your personal information to third parties unless we have your permission or are required by law to do so.

You may request details of any personal information which we hold about you, Subject Access Request, SAR. You will be required to submit personal identification to allow us to process your request, this includes Passport, driving licence or birth certificate. This will be actioned within 30days in line with Article 15 of the GDPR, The General Data Protection Regulations, by our Data Protection Officer, Charlene Watkin.
